Summer ART Classic Fine Art Festival

The annual SCAA Summer ART Classic Fine Art Festival takes place the second Saturday in August. The festival began in 1964 with a few local artists displaying their work on the Sauk County Courthouse Square in Baraboo, Wisconsin. Since then, the festival has grown into one of the premier small fine art festivals in Wisconsin, attracting artists from throughout the Midwest. The annual art festival is the SCAA's major fundraising event enabling it to continue its mission of involvement with and support of the visual arts in communities throughout Sauk County.

Member Exhibitions

During the year there are several opportunities for members to exhibit their work, including the annual themed exhibition in March and the annual **Encore!! Art – Reuse, Recycle, Rethink** exhibit to celebrate Earth Day.

Support for Sauk County's Young Artists

In 1975, the SCAA decided to encourage further education in the visual arts by initiating an annual scholarship to a continuing art student at the University of Wisconsin – Baraboo/Sauk County campus. Students are selected through the submission of their portfolios, which are then judged by a committee of association members. The scholarship is awarded to the one student possessing the best and most promising portfolio.

To assist county high school art departments, the SCAA makes an annual donation of \$500 each to two Sauk County high schools for art supplies or equipment. The following five high schools received the donations on a rotating

basis: Baraboo Senior High School, Reedsburg Area High School, Weston High School in Cazenovia, Sauk Prairie High School in Prairie du Sac and River Valley High School in Spring Green.
