<b>Who can enter</b>	All may enter, from young to old. It may be one person, two, or a team creating a single piece of artwork.
<b>Fee to enter</b>	Prices are as follows: Early Bird Fees: Adults, \$10; 18 and younger, Free Regular Fees: Adults, \$15; 18 and younger, \$5 Late Fees: Adults, \$20; 18 and younger, \$5 and a proud smile for Karen
<b>When and where is the show held</b>	Encore!! Art <b>is held</b> conjunction with the SAUK COUNTY EARTH DAY CELEBRATION. Check our website for the date and location of this event.

<b>Dead line for entry, Art Delivery Dates, And Artwork pick up</b>	Early Bird Entry postmarked on or before, March 1, 2020 Late Entry postmarked after Friday, April 10, 2020 Bring work to Sauk County Earth Day Celebration between 9 and 10 a.m.  Artwork not going to the Gallery should be picked up between 3 and 4 p.m. on Sunday. <b>What materials are acceptable</b>	Wood, paper, metal, and anything goes Entries must 75% recycled or reused, non-hazardous materials, with no sharp edges or points. Can be 2- or 3-dimensional, wearable, you decide.
<b>Size</b>	Be reasonable, has to easily pass through a 36" wide door. If heavy, over 20 pounds, you will need to move the art. If delicate, you should move the art.
<b>Judging</b>	Judging will be completed by 2 p.m. Sunday 22 <sup>nd</sup> . People's Choice will be counted at 3 p.m.
<b>Award Categories</b>	Originality, Most whimsical, Craftsmanship, & People's choice
<b>Displaying art work</b>	Tables will be at the SCED venue, if weather permits, we may display Some outside. If special displaying is required, you will furnish.
<b>Moving artwork</b>	SCAA will select pieces to move to the Schwalbach Gallery at the UW-Baraboo/Sauk Campus till the end of May. (Number of pieces will be determined by amount of space available in the Schwalbach Gallery.) Every effort will be made to keep your artwork from being damaged. SCAA and volunteers will not be held responsible for damage, breakage, loss or theft of artwork
<b>Selling artwork</b>	Artwork may be for sale. No commissions will be charged
